NOTE: Cluster events start at 9:00 A.M. on Thursday, and 8:00 A.M. on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

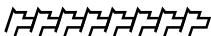

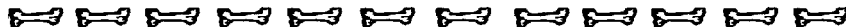

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

NR1.08100.20800. Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches seven (7) years & under ten (10) years. Veteran Classes must meet all requirements to compete for Best of Breed.

NR1.08100.38000. Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches ten (10) years & under twelve (12) years. Veteran Classes must meet all requirements to compete for Best of Breed.

NR1.08100.40000. Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches ten (12) years & under fourteen (14) years. Veteran Classes must meet all requirements to compete for Best of Breed.

NR1.08100.41900. Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches fourteen (14) years & over.

NR1.75800. Performance Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches, 6 months of age and over, who have earned at least one title in any AKC Companion or Performance Event (Agility, Herding, Obedience, Rally or Tracking). Dogs entered in these classes must not have been neutered or spayed. By virtue of winning these classes, the dog and bitch are eligible to compete for Best of Breed provided they have not been defeated in any other class.

00900. BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

SPECIAL ATTRACTION CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

NR2.43500. Altered Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches, six months of age or over who have been neutered or spayed. The dog and bitch winning these classes are not eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

SPECIAL ATTRACTION CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

NR2.09100. Stud Dog Class - Will be for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Stud Dog only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its breed.

NR2.09200. Brood Bitch - The same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog & Produce for Get.

NR2.09300. Brace - Two dogs of the same breed or variety and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. - The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc. As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch & Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Chapter 16 Section 1 Rules Applying to Dog Shows

*... at a Specialty the dog designated Reserve Winners Dog and the bitch designated Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winners' sex totals at least **TWICE** the number required for a five point major, in the region in which the event is held. No major for Reserve Winners shall be given based upon an award of Best of Winners.*

To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. From Highway 101, take exit 7B to Highway 12 East towards Sonoma. Take the first exit on the right (South E. Street Downtown) onto Bennett Valley Road and continue through the first stop light. Just in front of you, on your right will be the Sonoma County Event Center at the Fairgrounds.

If you are coming in from Highway 12, Westbound, take the Downtown exit, and turn left at the stop light onto Brookwood Avenue. The Fairgrounds will be ahead on your right after the stop light.
